Loans: *Law books:* may be borrowed by Masters of the Bench of the Inner Temple for their own use.

Non-law books: with certain exceptions, these may be borrowed by Inner Temple barristers in private practice with chambers in London.

Distance Services: Documents (subject to copyright) sent by fax, post or email to all Inner Temple Benchers, to barrister members of the Inner Temple working in private practice in chambers outside central London and to barristers of other Inns when the material is not held by their own Library.

Courtel Communications: listing information for all the Crown and Combined High Courts and the RCJ, plus some County Courts.

Databases available on the catalogue server: Current Law Cases (digests of reported cases and newspaper law reports 1947-), Legal Journals Index (an index to UK and EC journals including case comments 1986-) and the Legal and Regulatory Developments Index (an index to supplementary legal material mid 1993-).
