Canadian Abridgment


The Canadian Abridgment is a multi-volume work which can be used to:

The *Canada Gazette* is Canada's official newspaper, divided into three parts: Part I, Notices and proposed regulations; Part II, Regulations; Part III, Acts of Parliament. This site contains Gazettes for 1998 onwards. To browse by year select "Publications". The *Canada Gazette* is available in both pdf and html format. The pdf version is regarded as official from 2003 onwards. Earlier Gazettes will be found on the archive site, A Nation's Chronicle.

Federal Court of Canada

The Federal Court is Canada's national trial court, in succession to the Exchequer Court. The web site provides information on the history, administration and personnel of the court, including court rules, practice guides,



hearing lists and case histories. There are full text decisions from December 1990 onwards, although coverage is very selective before 1997.

The Canadian Parliament web site includes current Bills, which can be tracked using the "LEGISinfo" facility; also Hansard, substantive reports of committees, information on Senators and MPs and on the history and procedure of Parliament. Coverage is from 1994 onwards for Hansard and 2001 onwards for LEGISinfo.

FLAG Foreign Law Guide
