
Home Page

In the main search box you can enter your search terms.


If you only want to find cases use the drop down menu and select Cases.




Also on the home page is a My Sources tab. From here you can search for a specific law report series by clicking on Search Sources. Type in the title you need and click search.



Alternatively you can select View All Sources. An A-Z list of all sources will then appear. Click on the source you need. From here you can search or browse.

Click on the Content tab on the home page and select Cases. There are 3 options:

- Search box
- Content Type
- Topic

Content Type:

Here you can search for specific law reports or judgments or quantum decisions. If you click on Case Reports an A-Z list of all the reports available on Lexis+ UK will appear. By clicking on a title you have the choice of browsing or searching.


You can search more than one title by clicking Select sources to search.
