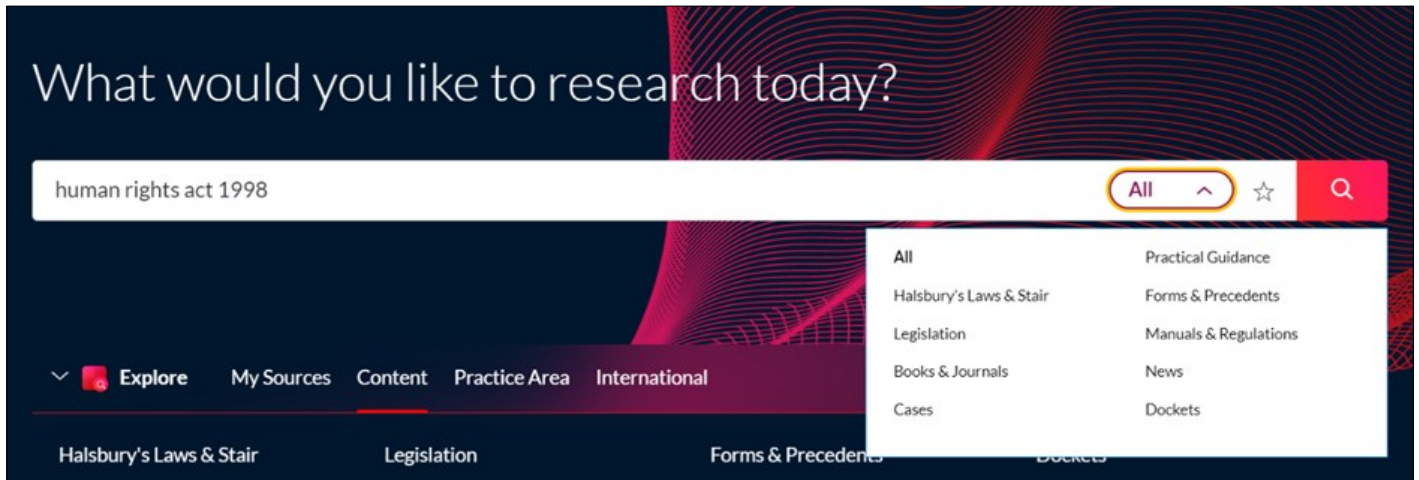
Quick Reference Guide



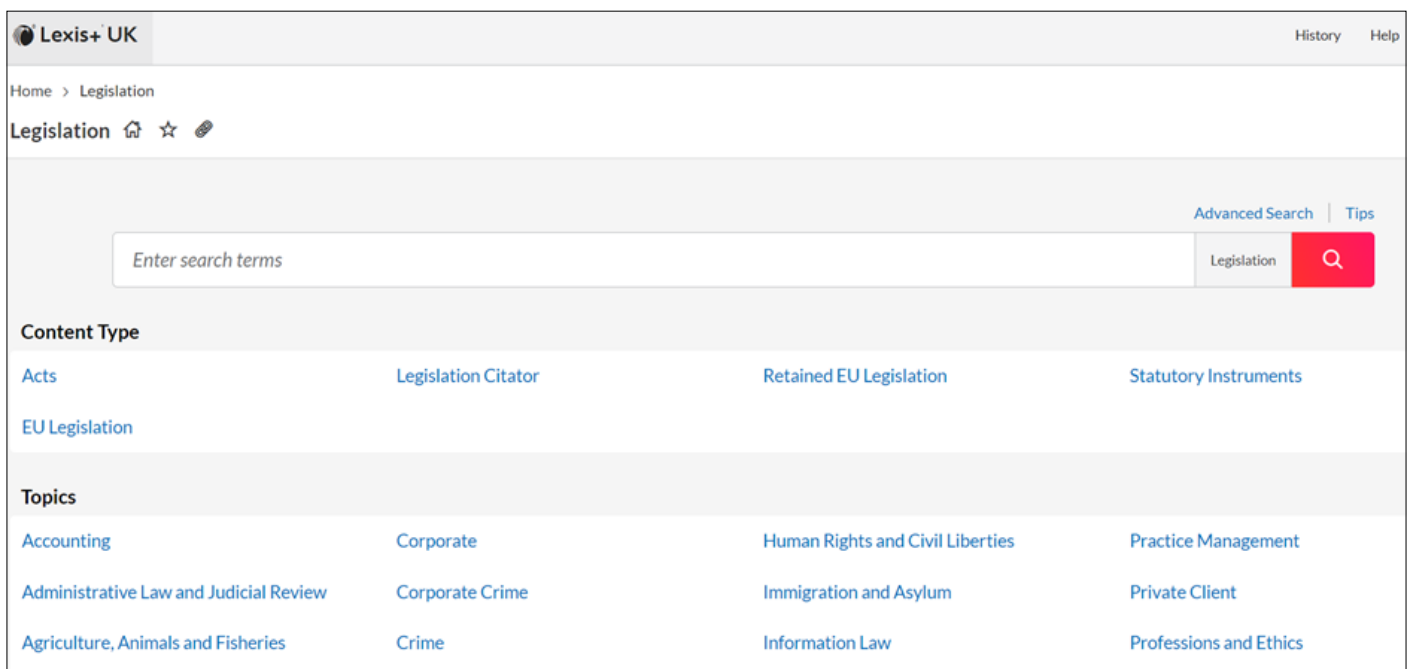
Home Page

In the main search box you can enter your search terms.

To restrict the search to legislation use the drop down menu and select Legislation.



Also on the home page is a Contents tab. Click on Legislation.



From here there are several ways to find legislation:

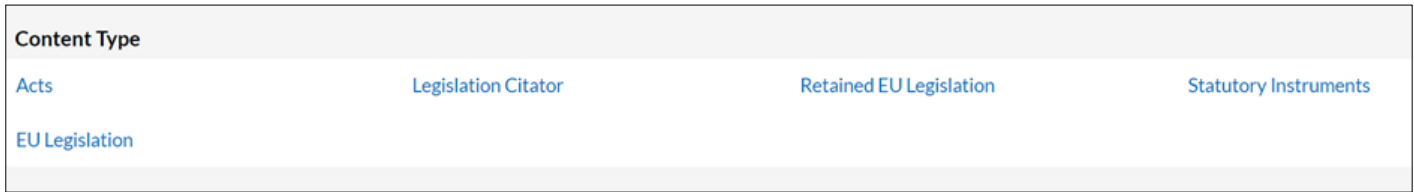
Search box:

Type in the legislation name or citation e.g. 1998 c.42

You can also use an advanced search option here.

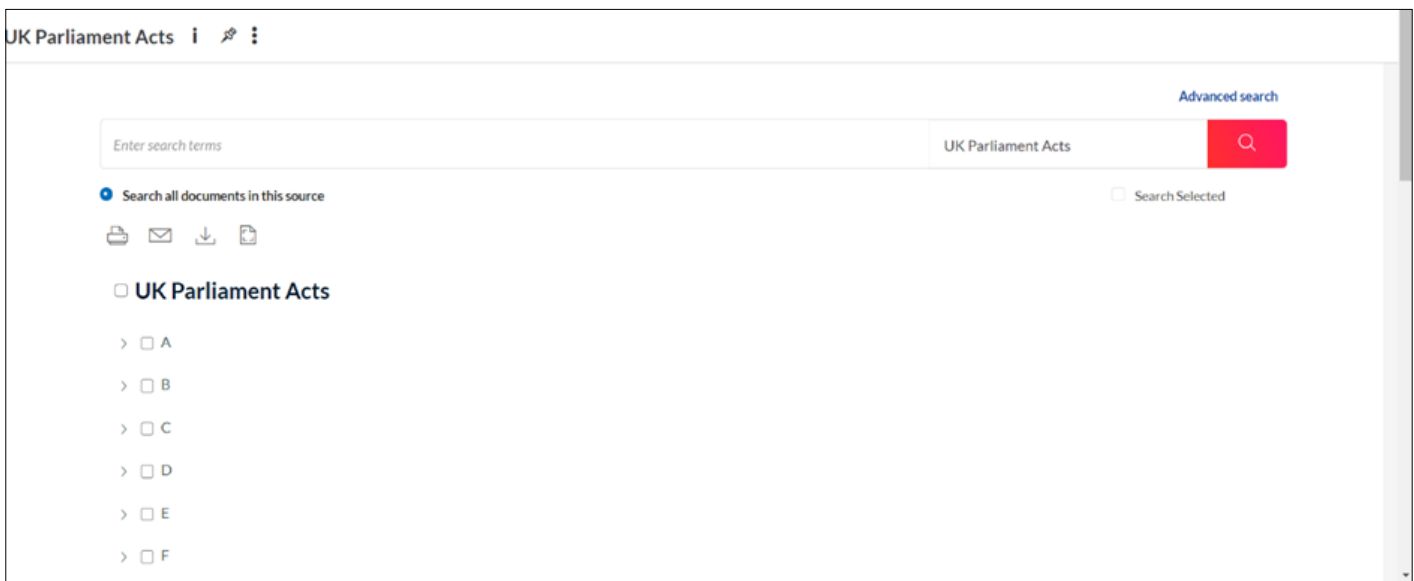
Content type:

There are several options to choose:

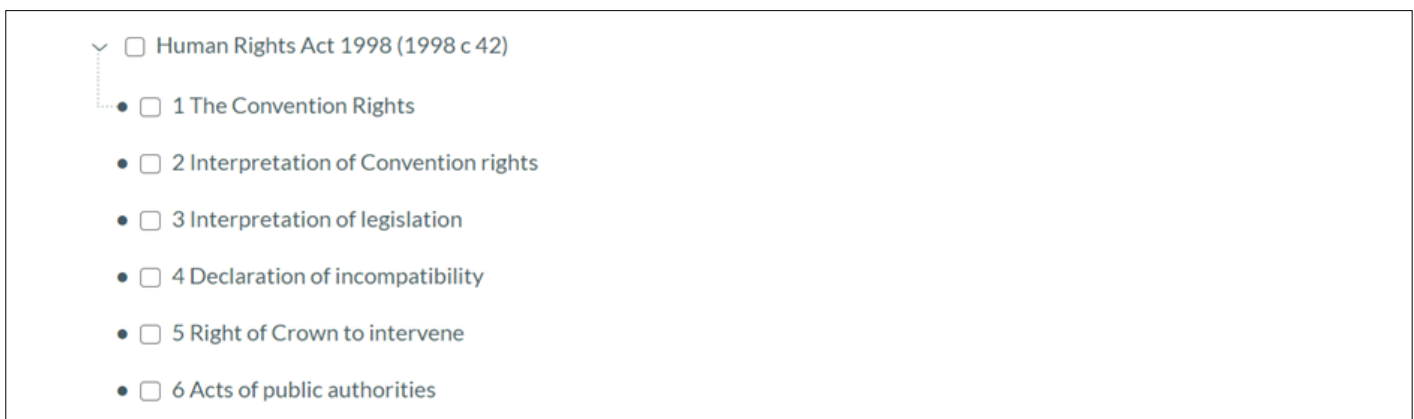


By clicking on Acts, you can choose UK Acts, Welsh Acts, Welsh Assembly Measures, Acts of the Scottish Parliament, Isle of Man Acts and Finance Acts.

If you select UK Acts, you can use a search box or browse via A-Z lists.



You can look for the whole Act or a section.



If you choose a section, the text of that section will appear in the centre of the screen.

The Notes at the bottom of the page will detail commencement and subordinate legislation.

On the right of the screen there will be Supporting Materials and Related Documents.

Remedial action
10 Power to take remedial action

(1) This section applies if—

(a) a provision of legislation has been declared under section 4 to be incompatible with a Convention right and, if an appeal lies—

(i) all persons who may appeal have stated in writing that they do not intend to do so;

(ii) the time for bringing an appeal has expired and no appeal has been brought within that time; or

(iii) an appeal brought within that time has been determined or abandoned; or

(b) it appears to a Minister of the Crown or Her Majesty in Council that, having regard to a finding of the European Court of Human Rights made after the coming into force of this section in proceedings against the United Kingdom, a provision of legislation is incompatible with an obligation of the United Kingdom arising from the Convention.
